Provided over 200 needy families in Pompano Beach with meals for the holidays

POMPANO BEACH, FLA. (January 27, 2010) – When most people think of disasters, they typically think of hurricanes, tornadoes and earthquakes. However, AshBritt recognized that families throughout the City of Pompano Beach are hit with financial disasters on a daily basis. In partnership with District 4 Commissioner Woodrow Portier, Vince Johnson from the Broward County Minority Builders Coalition, Inc. (BCMBA), and the Pompano Beach Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. (ΚΑΨ), employees of AshBritt Environmental went door to door to deliver the 150 turkeys the business donated for the residents of Pompano Beach, which provided over 200 families with meals for the holidays.

Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity's signature community outreach event, the annual Thanksgiving Basket Giveaway, has been delivering 30-50 donated baskets filled with holiday meal favorites for families in need since 2001. This year, AshBritt's donation of 30 turkeys allowed for ΚΑΨ to create 75 baskets for the residents of Pompano Beach.

"Needy families and individuals in our community go without proper food, shelter and essential medical care everyday due to a variety of reasons," said Brandon Choice, Pompano Beach Alumni Chapter Polemarch (President) of ΚΑΨ. "With the generous support of AshBritt, we were able to make progress against these challenges this holiday."

"We do this because we recognize that in good times and bad, one should always lend a helping hand when your neighbor is in need," said Chandler Williamson, chairman of the ΚΑΨ Thanksgiving Basket Giveaway. "Our mission is to help the single mother struggling to keep the lights on; the elderly man who has no family and cannot leave his home because physically, he can't; the family who has no idea when or where their next meal is coming. The Pompano Beach alumni chapter of ΚΑΨ strives to be a sign of hope for our neighbors who desperately need us."

In conjunction with The City of Pompano Beach District 4 Commissioner, Woodrow Poitier, and Broward County Minority Builders Coalition, Inc., the county's turkey giveaway fed over 140 underprivileged families of the Northwest Community Redevelopment Agency (NWCRA).

"Often, we attempt to think of ways to create a lasting influence in the lives of many economically disenfranchised people, who are less fortunate than ourselves. However, AshBritt's unwavering support and commitment within the
